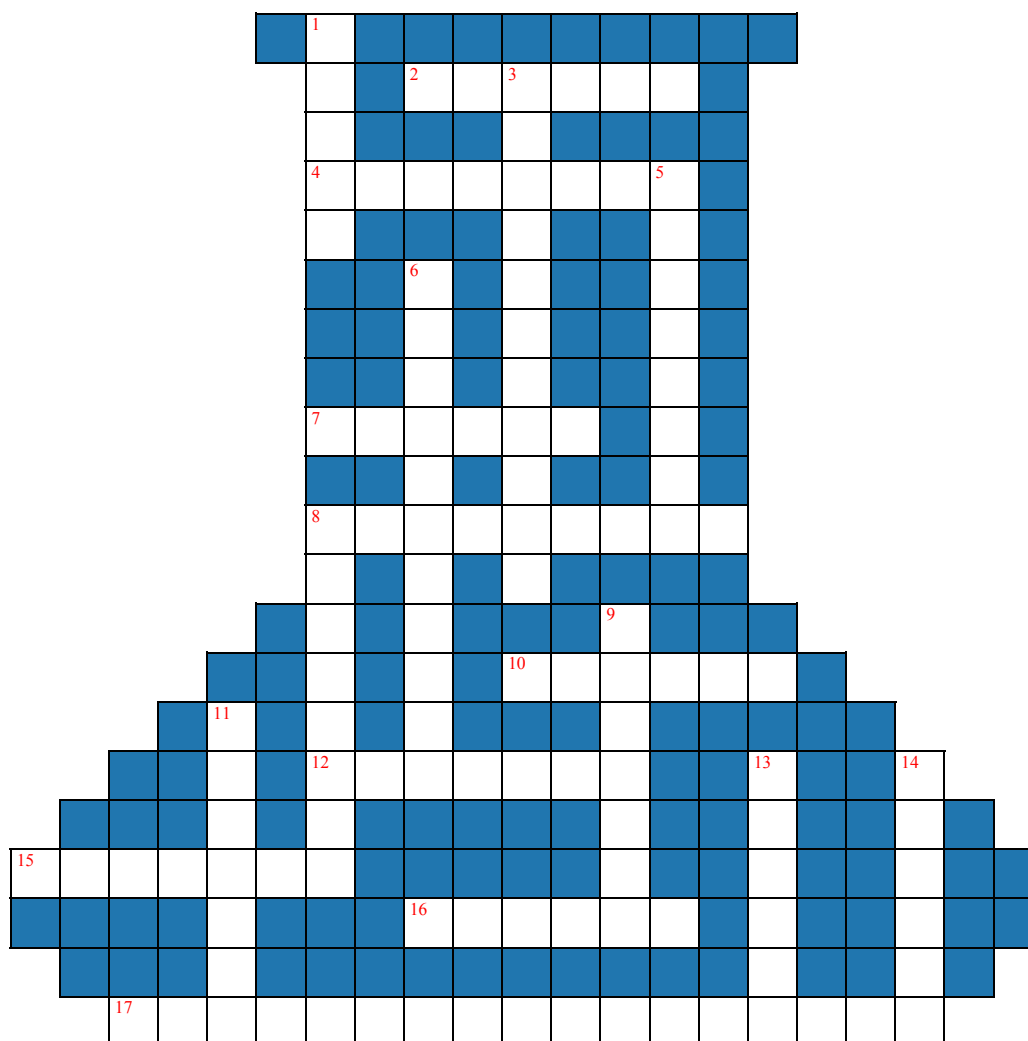


Chemistry apparatus

- 2 Anagram of rotter, used as a stand (6)
- 4 A metal mat used on a tripod when heating (5,3)
- 7 Funnel used to separate insoluble solids from liquids (6)
- 8 Anagram of dense corn - cold water goes through this to turn vapours into liquids (9)
- 10 Three-legged metal support (6)
- 12 Despite its name, this shelf doesn't buzz (7)
- 15 You can do titrations with this long glass tube (7)
- 16 A mug for a chemist? (6)
- 17 Tall graduated container for measuring volumes of liquids (9,8)

Down

- 1 These come in a pair and grip hot things (5)
- 3 You measure temperature with this (11)
- 5 A small cylindrical glass container used for experiments (4,4)
- 6 This tube may not always be hot, but you can warm solutions in it (7,4)
- 8 Porcelain container to heat reactants in (8)
- 9 Sounds like French for 'little pip' - used to add liquids (7)
- 11 A spoon for a chemist? (7)
- 13 Named after a famous Robert, a burner used in chemistry (6)
- 14 Thick-walled glass cylinder to contain substances in the gas state (3,3)
